Since ECMA TR/84 3^{rd} edition is made up of a XML file which is part of the fast-tracked Standard ECMA-335 3^{rd} edition and ECMA TR/89 1^{st} edition requires facilities that are being added to the commented version of ECMA TR/84, we therefore wish to await the publication of the three above mentioned ISO/IEC Standards before proceeding the publication of the ISO/IEC TR 23272 and 25438 although these two Technical reports have been adopted without comments during the fast-track process.


Rooms must be reserved directly at the hotels before the 10 March 2006.
