? ?Transportation

1. From overseas cities to Nara City

1.1 Airports

The most convenient means of transportation is a direct flight to the Kansai International Airport (KIX).

If you arrive at New Tokyo International Airport (Narita), you should transfer and fly again to KIX or Osaka Airport (Itami) from Narita. You can go to Nara by train (Narita-Express and Shin-kan-sen) but it takes about 5 hours from Narita to Nara.

1.2 From KIX to Nara

The simplest route from KIX to Nara is the Airport Limousine Bus, which takes approximately 90 minutes to arrive at Nara Hotel, Kintetsu Nara Station and JR Nara Station. The bus leaves KIX at 7:40, 8:40, 10:40, 12:40, 13:40, 14:40, 15:40, 16:40, 17:40, 18:40, 19:40, and 20:40. It costs 1,800 yen one way, per person. It departs from bus stop No. 9. Should there be any inquiries regarding access to Nara, please ask at the Information Desk at the airport on the first floor (the ground floor) in front of the arrivals area.

If you stay at Nara Hotel, the Airport Limousine Bus from KIX is very convenient because it stops at the hotel.

If you stay at Mitsui Garden Hotel Nara, get off the bus at JR Nara Station.

1.3 From Osaka Airport (Itami) to Nara

The easiest way to get to Nara from Osaka Airport (Itami) is to take an airport limousine bus that goes to JR Nara Station via Kintetsu Nara Station. The bus fare is 1,440 yen, and it takes about 60 minutes. The bus leaves South terminal of Itami at 8:30, 9:05, 10:05, 11:05, 12:05, 13:30, 14:30, 15:30, 16:30, 17:20, 18:20, 19:00, 19:30, 20:00, 20:35, and 21:15 and stops at North terminal of Itami 5 minutes later. It departs from bus stop No. 10 of South terminal of Itami and stops at bus stop No. 0 of North terminal of Itami.

If you stay at Mitsui Garden Hotel Nara, get off the bus at JR Nara Station.

If you stay at Nara Hotel, get off at JR or Kintetsu Nara Station and take a taxi there.

Kintetsu Nara Station: 5 minutes by car.

JR Nara Station: 7 minutes by car.

1.4 Railways

There are two major railway stations in Nara City, i.e., JR Nara Station and Kintetsu Nara Station.

If you prefer to take trains to come to JR Nara Station from KIX, take JR Hanwa line and change at Tennoji Station to JR Yamatoji line. If you prefer to come to Kintetsu Nara Station from KIX by train, take Nankai line and change at Namba Station to Kintetsu Nara line. We do not recommend you to take Nankai line and Kintetsu line, since Namba station is so big, crowded and complicated that you might get lost.

2. Access to Nara-ken New Public Hall

The Nara-ken New Public Hall is located in the Nara Park.

From Nara Hotel, it takes only ten minutes to walk to the Hall.

From JR Nara station, take a city bus with numbers either of 70, 88, 97, 98, or 133, or a bus bound for "Kasugataisha-honden" and get off at "Ken-Shin-Koukaidou" (approximately a ten-minute ride).

From Kintetsu Nara Station, take a city bus with numbers either of 70, 88, 97, 98, or 133, or a bus bound for "Kasugataisha-honden" and get off at "Ken-Shin-Koukaidou" (approximately a five-minute ride).

From "Ken-Shin-Koukaidou", it is only a few minutes walk to the Nara-ken New Public Hall.

The cost of the taxi ride from JR Nara Station or Kintetsu Nara Station to Nara-ken New Public Hall should be around 700~1,100 yen. In most cases, the driver does not understand English. Just tell him/her your destination, like "Nara-ken shin koh-kai-doe" (Japanese call the hall this way)

NOTE: The taxis and buses in Nara may not accept credit cards. You should prepare necessary amount of cash before you arrive at Nara. The best way to reach your destination without mistakes is to show the address to the bus driver or taxi driver. He will have pleasure to help you.

?? Car driving

We do not recommend that you drive a car in Japan unless you know Japan and its language very well. Cars run on the left. They must stop on red.

?? Climate

September Weather in Nara -- Temperature

Average: 23.7 Celsius

Deviations: 20.2 - 28.0 Celsius

Notes: It is rather hot and wet in the middle of September in Nara. It rains at least once a week and relatively heavy.

Currency— Japanese Yen: Notes are in denominations of 1,000, 2000, 5,000, and 10,000 Yen. Coins are in denominations of 1, 5, 10, 50, 100, and 500Yen. 2000 Yen Notes was issued in July 2000 and you rarely see it now.

Currency exchange— Exchange services are provided at KIX, Narita Airport. But all the hotels and banks in Japan do not provide the services. Participants are recommended to exchange at the airports or before coming to Japan. The exchange rate is approximately 130 yen/dollar as of writing but the rate may vary.

Credit cards— Visa and MasterCard are accepted throughout Japan, but Diners Club and American Express tend to be unavailable. Check with your credit card company for details of merchant acceptability and other services which may be available. Visitors are advised to carry at least one major credit card, as it is common to request prepayment for hotels rooms. Taxis and small restaurants usually do not accept the payment by credit card.

Holidays— 15th, Senior Citizens' Day, and 23rd, Autumnal Equinox Day, are National holidays in September 2002.

Tax— Consumption tax on purchases (goods and services): 5%.

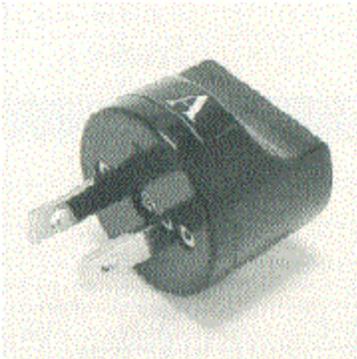
Tiping— There is no culture of tipping in Japan.

Taxi— The door opens automatically.

Emergency Numbers—Dial 110 to call the police, and dial 119 to call an ambulance or a fire engine. But you need to explain, probably in Japanese, who you are, where you are, what you see, etc.

Time Zone— Japan has single time zone.

Electricity supply—100 V, 60 Hz in Nara. The Power-outlet is A type. The plug has two flat prongs(no third prong for ground, or earth). Those two prongs are parallel and are same width and length.



Phone connector— RJ-11, the same type that is used in the U.S.
