#### Disposition of Comments on the JTC1 Ballot of DIS 8859-2 issued on 1997-03-22.

Most comments accompanying the ballot are identical to comments made for 8859-1 also, and they are accepted or rejected exactly as in the Disposition of Comments for that part (see ISO/IEC/JTC1/SC2/WG3 N 410).

The disposition of the comments that are specific to this part 2 are given below:

## **Ireland (N):**

First paragraph: Accepted in principle.

The following note will be added to clause 6.1:

that are specified in this part 2 of ISO/IEC 8859. However, subject to the agreement of originator and receiver in information interchange the letters WITH CEDILLA in Part 2 may be used to substitute for the letters WITH COMMA BELOW.

#### ISRAEL (N)

Accepted in principle.

See disposition of comment for Ireland above.

#### **ROMANIA (N)**

Accepted in principle.

The character names cannot be changed now because the standard has been in wide use for over ten years. A change could only cause conflict or non-conformity in existing product implementations. However an explanatory note will be added, see "IRELAND" above.

### UK

#### **USA**

Second Paragraph. Not accepted: The fonts used for printing ISO/IEC 10646-1 are not available to the editor. However the glyphs chosen will be a typical rendering of the named characters.
