A #include preprocessing directive causes the named header or source file to be processed from phase 1 through phase 4, recursively. All preprocessing directives are then deleted.

1 A ## preprocessing token shall not occur at the beginning or at the end of a replacement list for either form of macro definition

2 A character sequence that matches the syntax of a universal character name shall not be produced by token concatenation.
