Finally we can celebrate acceptance of the C++ standard, our FDIS having advanced to IS status! We now must establish working procedures for the 5-year period of stability. That primarily means procedures for handling Defect Reports, and determining a publication schedule for Technical Corrigenda.

We will determine when and how we will entertain proposals for new or revised features in the C++ standard, some of which might lead to additional new Projects.

The C Committees, J11 and WG14, will be meeting during the week at the same hotel. They prefer that non-members don't show up at a session just to visit. They have a lot of work to do getting out their CD. ISO rules prohibit attendance at a WG meeting of any non-accredited person. ANSI J committee meetings are open in principle. If you wish to attend a J11 meeting and are not a member, please make arrangements with a J11 representative, as a matter of common courtesy. Of course, if your organization has an ongoing interest in C standardization, you should join J11. That would also serve to increase cooperation between the C and C++ committees.
