Regards the X3J11 Responses to Issues Raised During First Public Review
(Document Number X3J11/87-206)

The above document along with the associated X3J11 Responses to Issues Raised by Letters from the Public (Document Number X3J11/87-207) were reviewed by the BSI C Panel at their most recent meeting on the 9th February 1988. We are concerned that neither document contained a response to Alan Mycroft's comments. These were submitted directly to X3 as well as forming a large part of the UK comments submitted to X3J11 during the First Public Review. My records show that these comments were circulated by X3J11 as document X3J11/87-103 20 Feb 87 [L-146] Letter, Alan Mycroft. At the Paris meeting of X3J11, these comments were assigned to a group for processing; unfortunately, this processing appears to have never been done. Inspecting subsequent minutes of X3J11, I cannot find any further discussion relevant to this matter. It was agreed by the BSI C Panel that this constituted a serious breach of procedure; as our understanding is that X3J11 is under an obligation to respond to all comments received during the Public Review.

At the request of the BSI C Panel, I am writing to bring this matter to your attention as ISO Convenor and Secretary to X3J11. We look forward to the rectification of this oversight.
