Disposition of Comments on SC22/N1445, Proposed Technical Corrigendum to ISO/IEC 9899:1990 Programming Language C

6 April 1994

SC22/N1532 provides the summary of voting and comments received on the Proposed Technical Corrigendum (TC) to ISO/IEC 9899:1990. Briefly, we in committee WG14 were informed that:

14 members supported the TC without comments

1 member supported the TC with comments

0 members did not support the TC registration

1 member abstained

7 did not vote

We found the comments from Canada helpful in clarifying the intent of the TC and have incorporated them in a revised draft. We also received a number of suggestions for small improvements and minor corrections through less formal channels from various members of SC22, which we have also gratefully incorporated.

WG14 met 1-3 December 1993 in Kona, Hawaii and reviewed these votes and comments. Four members sent delegations of technical experts: Denmark, Japan, United Kingdom, and USA. After deliberation, the committee voted to adopt these various minor revisions to the TC. Once the TC is reviewed by a subcommittee, the Convener is instructed to submit the document for registration at Technical Corrigendum 1 to ISO/IEC 9899:1990.

The Convener is also instructed to submit a revised version of SC22/N1444, WG14's Record of Responses to Defect Reports #001 through #059. This document is a superset of the TC, showing the responses that resulted in both normative changes and non-normative clarifications. Hence, it should be kept in agreement with the revisions made to the TC.
